We learnt about what school life would have been like for children living in the Victorian over 100 years ago!



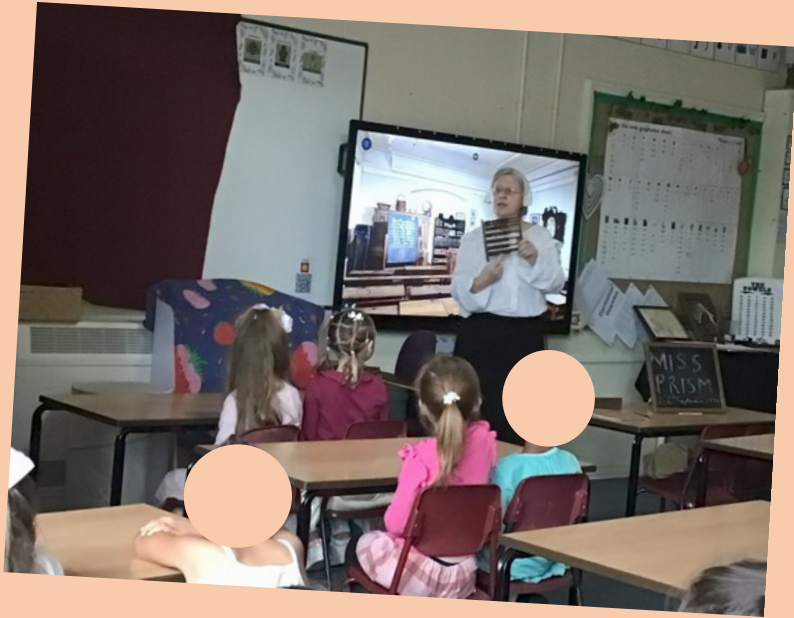
As a punishment
