2. Wellbeing, Behaviour and Safeguarding

All children spoke positively about school. The children asked said they felt safe in school and knew who they could talk to if they didn't feel safe. Mrs Miller reminded SC that next week would be Mental Health Week, Safer Internet Day and Stay Safe Assembly Week at Streetsbrook – a chance for everyone to think about the importance of these things.
