- Led by volunteer Parent Group Leaders
- Delivered face-to-face & virtually
- Group runs for 8 weeks
 - Face to Face: 2 hours per week
 - Virtual: 90 mins per week
- Being a Parent aims to improve child development & outcomes, parenting & family resilience and has positive outcomes for children's behaviour.



Understanding Your Child

- Led by people from a range of professional backgrounds
- Delivered face-to-face
- Group runs 2 hours per week for 10 weeks
- Evidence based & underpinned by the 3 key principles of:
 - Containment
 - Reciprocity
 - Behaviour management
- Universal in content, but adaptable for a range of ages and needs
