Nursery

Nursery have been continuing to practise their circus skills this week and I must say, there are getting very good!

The spinning plates have been particularly popular and some children are even managing to spin two at a time!

With the weather being so lovely this week again, most of the children have chosen to spend their time outdoors where we have had a variety of water activities for them to explore. They have been playing 'hook a duck', exploring our water tray and we also set up a pony wash and dry station!

We have also planted some carrot seeds this week and we are looking forward to looking after our seeds and watching them grow.

During phonics, we have been singing 'The Wheels on the Bus' and playing listening games linked to this. All the children are doing a great job recognising rhyming words now! We listened to and had a go at making the sound /qu/: pucker your mouth and then open it as you say **qu**. It has been a very short half term, but we have managed to have so much fun in! When we return after the half term break, we will continue with our Circus theme until we are ready to welcome our grown-ups into school on Friday 13th June for our fun-filled Circus workshop! We hope you all have a fantastic week off and look forward to welcoming the children back to Nursery for our final half term.



Year 2

Year 2 have enjoyed their final week of this half term. We have been recording how many of us have walked, scooted or cycled to school this week as part of Walk to School Week. In Maths, we have been planning, creating and playing our own board games. The children have really enjoyed the challenge of making their own maths-based games and it was lovely to see them explaining their games' rules to their friends. In English, we have been writing our adventure stories. Wow! The children really used their imagination to make their stories exciting and thought about the vocabulary and punctuation that they used. In Science this week, we have been focusing our attention on the Savannah habitat. We drew a picture of this before labelling the items as living, dead or never living. After half term, we will be starting our final half term of Streetsbrook. To support the children's transition, we would love for them to start walking up the ramp on their own in the morning. If you have an urgent message, please do continue to speak with the staff on the door or email the office.

Year 1

What a fantastic week we've had! We enjoyed a brilliant afternoon at Sharmans Cross for Sports Day. A huge thank you to all the families who came along to cheer us on; your support really made the day special. In the classroom, we've been busy in Maths, practising our addition and subtraction skills and using different methods to solve problems. In English, we retold the story of *The Deep Dark Wood*, focusing on using capital letters, full stops, and finger spaces in our writing – the children worked really hard and produced some lovely pieces of work. Our Science lessons have been especially exciting as we continue observing our broad bean plants. The children have been carefully measuring and recording their growth, and some of our beans have already reached an impressive 10cm tall! We hope everyone has a restful and enjoyable half-term break. When we return for Summer 2, we have lots to look forward to. Our topic work will focus on the United Kingdom, where we'll be learning about coastal and inland towns, comparing their features and discussing what makes them unique. In English, we'll be diving into the beautiful story *The Storm Whale* by Benji Davies, which ties in perfectly with our seaside theme. In Maths, we'll be exploring the concept of one more and one less than a given number, helping to build strong number sense. We can't wait for our exciting trip to Weston-super-Mare – it's going to be a brilliant start to the new half-term!

Reception

We can't quite believe it's the end of term already, we have managed to squeeze so much in!

We have been reading the story 'The Lion Inside' and thinking about what our strengths are and what makes us a good friend- the children have enjoyed talking about their friends strengths and what they love about them.

We had so much fun on Tuesday at Sports Day, we were so proud of how well the children managed in the heat, not only participating in the races but also walking all the way to Sharmans Cross. The children were so proud of themselves the next day and talked about who had won races which prompted some lovely discussions about how we all can't win all the time, and about beating our own personal bests which lots of the children managed to do! In phonics we have learnt our last 2 tricky words **today** and **out**, please ensure you are practicing these with your child as there are so many and some of the children are finding it tricky to remember them. We have also been recapping the words with tricky endings like -ed (t) and -est where they make a different sound. Our focus story this week has been *The 3 Billy Goats Gruff*. We have used this to support our writing, build bridges for the goats to cross and think about prepositions such as under, on top and behind. We hope you have a lovely half term and we look forward to seeing you for the last half-term of Reception!

Gentle reminder- please can you ensure you are sending back any spare clothes your child has borrowed as we now have no spare clothes in school at all.

This week, because we are approaching the holiday and final half-term we have been looking back over the year. We have looked at the photos of our adventures and talked about what we did and what we learned. We also looked through the class books we made together, this led onto a class quiz to see what facts we could remember about the things we have been doing. We worked together to plan the next half-term, discussing all the activities and fun days we want to do based around favourite moments from the year so far. Next term we will be concentrating on transitions, we will be supporting the children with the moves they will be making in September, looking at uniforms, meeting teachers, looking at classrooms as well as talking about excitement or any worries they may have. Please remember to bring hats daily when we return. Have a lovely half term we look forward to seeing you for our final half-term before the summer.
